1964-65 GTO 4-Flue Radiator from car with (3) 2 barrel carbs / for Manual Trans car (no A/T trans cooler) / 15" high core (not for A/C equipped car – they have a 17" high core) / Original Pontiac Radiator / Inlet and outlet on passenger side / in good shape and ready to go. **(\$250)**

1964-65 GTO Hydraulic steering stabilizer COMPLETE / installed on cars with manual steering ONLY to mitigate wander / works great / stabilizer cylinder is new from Ames catalog G40 for (\$79.00). There are no aftermarket brackets made so you will have to have factory brackets from a 1964 or 1965 GTO / the bracket mounted between steering box and frame is almost impossible to find / works best with 389 with original factory oil pan. This item can be seen in "Pontiac GTO Restoration Guide" by Paul Zazarine & Chuck Roberts. OPG or NPD does not have them. **(\$175)**

1970 – 1972 GTO Rear Spoiler / Aftermarket / see Summit Racing item #OPG-GBB0055 at \$346.99 / used but in good condition. **(\$200)**

1970 – 1972 GTO Floor Mats / Aftermarket / see Summit Racing item #OPG-CFP313SD at \$139.99 / used but in good condition. **(\$50)**

1968 A/T center console / This is a real factory-installed GTO A/T console. NO ONE makes a 1968 Auto Trans console. You can get a '68 M/T console from AMES but not an A/T console. You can get a 1969 GTO A/T console from Ames with all the crap for \$539.00 but it isn't

correct for a '68 GTO. My console has the box liner, the lid hinge and the special metal plate so you can bolt it to the shifter. I guess the re-pops just screw to the floor and the console just floats around the shifter. It is black and in good condition. It does not have the console door you lean on but Ames has that at \$49.00. **(\$200)**

Borg Warner Super T-10 4-speed Transmission from 1977 Trans Am. After about 2 years the T-10 was swapped out for an M-22 Muncie so this one has been sitting in my garage since.

26 spline input / large spline output (T-400 type) / 2.43 1st gear / Hurst heavy duty shifter rods and Hurst shifter mounting plate – all you need is just the shifter itself. **(\$1,500)**
