



After holding cruise in events at the Riverstone parking lot for over 30 years, our club was presented with unexpected news.


The Riverstone parking lot recently changed ownership which resulted in the PoBoys having to look for another venue to hold our events.

Death of a Car Club

Farewell Peach State Chevelles Club (1984—2023)

As Jim mentioned in his President's Message, Atlanta has recently lost a long time car club, Peach State Chevelles. See the below final email from club president Ken Kucera to members. Many of the issues the club faced are currently being experienced by SEGTOA. So far, we've made it almost 40 years as a club. Without your participation we aren't anything more than a bunch of old guys (and gals) with old cars taking up space in the garage. Consider what you can do to help keep our club going—even if it's just showing up at events.

Peach State Chevelles Current & Past Club Members,

I hope all is well.

On Sunday March 5, 2023, the President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Peach State Chevelles, Inc. (a Georgia Domestic Nonprofit Corporation) and 5 club members attended our Q1 2023 Quarterly Club meeting at Calvin Cannon's home.

At the meeting, we had discussions about the status and future of the club. After much input from all officers and members in attendance, a resolution was brought to the table by Ken Kucera, President and seconded by Grady Wood, Founder of the club.

The resolution included the following items:

- Whereas the current and previous Club Members are grateful for all of those who founded and worked so hard with the club over the years starting in 1984 and
- Whereas the Club Members agree that the club is all about the relationships built over the years and not just about the cars and
- Whereas the Club Members agree that as we grow older, some club members are having challenges with health and travel and
- Whereas since the Club no longer organizes and runs the annual Chevelle car show and
- Whereas the costs to maintain the

corporate structure of Peach State Chevelles, Inc. and all associated website and administrative costs.

Therefore, a resolution was brought to the table and received unanimous approval and included the following items:

- The legal entity of Peach State Chevelles, Inc. will be administratively dissolved at the State of Georgia Secretary of State effective as of 03/31/23.
- Any members who paid dues since the final car show on 09/10/22 will receive a \$25 refund check to be mailed by our club treasurer.
- The Club Treasurer will pay all outstanding club expenses from our current bank account which has a balance of approximately \$1,700 after the \$400 in membership dues refunds.
- After all club expenses are paid the treasurer, will donate the remain balance to Shriners & St. Jude Children's Hospitals.
- The Club Treasurer will file the 2022 Form 990 and the final 2023 Form 990 indicating "Final return/terminated" and "Check this box if the organization discontinued its operations."

The website located at www.peachstatechevelles will be closed on March 31, 2023. The website url will direct interested people to a new car group site.

- A new Peach State Chevelles car group site hosted at GroupSpot will be established as a self-service place for all existing and previous members to keep in communication with each other with no membership fees or club structure. All existing and previous Club members will receive an invitation to join the group and will be able to invite others to join as well.
- To join the new car group site, you will be asked 3 questions... 1. What model Chevrolet do you own... Chevelle, Chevelle Wagon or El Camino? 2. What year is your car? and 3. What color is your car?
- All car group app members will be able to download the GroupSpot Android and iPhone app for their phones or access the site on their computer.
- All car group members will be able to post messages, photos and create events on the new site.

It has been an honor to serve as your President over the past few years and wish you and your family many blessings to come.


